- Must be pursuing one of the following degree programs with an interest in the insurance industry: (CHECK ONE)
 - Business or business related
 - Finance, Accounting, or Economics
 - Mathematics, Statistics, Analytics, or Actuarial
 - Insurance, Risk Management, or Law
 - Computer Information systems or Data Mining/Modeling

- Must be a full time (12 credits minimum) student during the Fall 2019 semester (Please submit current or future schedule with application.)

- Must be enrolled in at least one 3-credit degree-related course for Fall 2019 (waived for high school applicants)

- Must have a minimum 2.5 GPA for the prior full-time semester; or, for last year in high school. The GPA report must be signed by the school's registrar. (Please submit with application.)

- Must submit a brief essay describing educational and career plans and outlining why you are deserving of this scholarship award. Essay must be prepared using word processing software and printed, double-spaced, of 500 words or more, and attached to this application form. Please include any insurance affiliations including internships, part-time or full-time positions in the insurance field, career interests related to insurance, etc.

- Must submit a letter of recommendation from a faculty member, either from high school or college.
